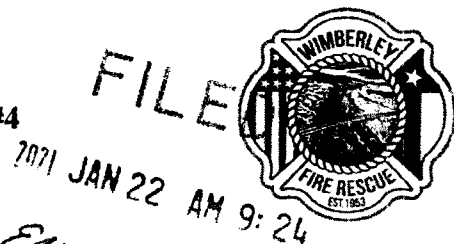


**HAYS COUNTY
